Infection Label	When you will see it	What it means
<p style="background-color: #e67e22; color: white; padding: 5px; border: 1px solid #ccc;">Infection: PreProcedure Screening COVID-19</p>	<p>Pt has active order for Pre Procedure COVID-19 screening test (that may or may not have been collected)</p>	<p>The patient is being screened for COVID-19 prior to an elective procedure per IDPH requirements.</p> <p>Universal masking should be performed.</p> <p>This infection will auto resolve when the COVID-19 test results</p>
<p style="background-color: #c0392b; color: white; padding: 5px; border: 1px solid #ccc;">Infection: R/O COVID-19</p>	<p>Pt has active order for COVID-19 test (that may or may not have been collected)</p>	<p>Pt is being tested for COVID-19 – pt may or may not be symptomatic</p> <p>Pt is a PUI (Person Under Investigation) – precautions should be taken until test results</p> <p>This infection will auto resolve when the COVID-19 test results</p>
<p style="background-color: #c0392b; color: white; padding: 5px; border: 1px solid #ccc;">Infection: COVID-19</p>	<p>When COVID-19 lab results as “detected” infection will auto-populate; If patient tested at outside facility and is confirmed positive, infection flag can be added by Care Team</p>	<p>Pt is COVID-19 positive</p> <p>Utilize Airborne/Contact/Eye precautions</p> <p>This infection will auto resolve in 30 days</p>
<p style="background-color: #27ae60; color: white; padding: 5px; border: 1px solid #ccc;">Infection: Post COVID-19</p>	<p>Pt has recovered from COVID-19 (based on CDC symptom-based discontinuation of transmission precautions guidelines); This flag will typically be used in Acute Rehab</p>	<p>Standard precautions are all that is necessary</p> <p>This infection will auto resolve in 30 days.</p>
